About the Program:


This 7 days intensive acupuncture/yoga retreat will take you to the journey diving deep into self, understanding 8 limbs of yoga, chakra system, prana/energy system, nadis/marma point system, and acquire knowledge, skills and methods to work and develop yourself in order to be able to support the others, and how to use acupuncture to heal others by heighten one's vibration, realigning all level of dan tians, major meridians, regulate and eliminate energetic/emotional blockage to open/activate chakra system using the combination of acupuncture points and marma points, cleanse nadis to help one advance in their soul journey.

Situated in the renowned historic spiritual island of Bali steeped in temples and inordinate charm, this program is designed to greatly enrich and polish the senses while developing and refining the healer's skills and technique of reading the non-physical body and working with subtle energy. You will learn a broad spectrum of healing approaches and come away with skills you can readily apply in your practice and achieve lasting clinical results. The learning format consists of lecture, observation and practical experience with teacher feedback. Expect to learn a lot and greatly broaden your perspective while laying a solid foundation for your future as a

healer.

Sight-Seeing:

Bali is known as the Land of the Gods, Bali appeals through its sheer natural beauty of looming volcanoes and lush terraced rice fields that exude peace and serenity. Bali enchants with its dramatic dances and colorful ceremonies, its arts, and crafts, to its luxurious beach resorts and exciting nightlife. And everywhere, you will find intricately carved temples.



As Bali is located 8 degrees south of the equator, you will find the climate to be the typical tropical, warm and humid all year round with two main distinctive seasons: Dry Season and Rainy Season. Some of the areas around Bali's central mountains (volcanoes) have several peaks over 3,000 meters above sea levels. Up here the temperatures are considerably cooler, and there is much more rainfall than in the coastal areas.

On day 4 of the program we will embark on a sight-seeing adventure to the sacred water purification temple, Tirta Empul, Uluwatu Temple, Ubud Art Market where we can shop at boutiques featuring local craftsmanship and art, Pura Ulun Danu Bratan, Tegallalang Rice Terrace and more.



Accommodations:

Rooms are reserved at the Adiwana Resort Jembawan which is situated in the city of Ubud and close to many shops and markets, and WiFi is available. The venue offers free shuttle to/from the airport has a restaurant, spa and beautiful yoga pavilion. Meals:

You will be welcomed to this seminar retreat with the grand Welcome Dinner on the first day evening, an Indonesian dining experience, with a ritual ceremony and the dance entertainment to get you jump right into the mood which is included in the seminar fee. A daily breakfast, lunch, afternoon tea and dinner are included in the room price.



Travel:

Getting around Bali is relatively easy. Uber and Taxi are easiest for foreigners comparing to taking local transportation such as public buses. Some apps like Grab is recommended to avoid unauthorized taxi with higher prices. The Wifi is available at the airport but not the outside. If you use apps, make sure to use them within the range, then go out of the airport. Most of people speak English. Travelers are advised to have cash on hand in case you need to take a taxi or shop at small stores as they are not always equipped to accept credit cards.



WHEN:

Monday, June 19th – Sunday, June 25th, 2023

Plan to arrive early to make sure you are able to attend the Orientation Meeting at 9am on June 19th. It is best to arrive a day or more in advance if possible to allow time for travel, settling in and adjusting to the time difference. Everyone will stay through the end of the seminar on Sunday, June 25th and plan their departure for anytime thereafter.

GETTING THERE:

Bali is a province of Indonesia and located east of Java and the international airport is at Denpasar. Usually transit at Taipei or Singapore then to Denpasar **Ngurah Rai International Airport (DPS)**

Local Travel in Bali:

Hotel offers a shuttle service to nearby city center where many shops, markets and restaurants are to entertain you.

Travel Insurance:

All participants are required to purchase and show proof of travel insurance, which must include accident/sickness and trip cancellation (VERY unlikely to happen – however for liability purposes we must require this coverage).
